## 04 Days Academic Leadership Training Program

### Aligarh Muslim University Murshidabad Centre

Aligarh Muslim University Murshidabad Centre organized a 04 Days Academic Leadership Training Program for Vice-Chancellors, Pro Vice-Chancellors, Directors, Deans, Chairpersons, Head of the Departments, College Principals and Vice-Principals from September 10-13, 2018. The program was organized under the aegis of Centre for Academic Leadership and Education Management (CALEM), AMU, Aligarh under the scheme of Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (PMMMNMTT) of Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India.

Dr. Amir Jafar, Director In-charge, AMU Murshidabad Centre welcomed the resources persons and the participants in the inaugural session. He said that AMU Murshidabad Centre offers a learning environment that is conducive to overall personality development. He also informed that very senior academicians will deliberate over the issues which leaders of higher educational institutions face on daily basis. A documentary on Aligarh Muslim University highlighting University's role in nation building was also screened in the inaugural function.

On day one, Prof. Mohd. Muzammil, Ex-Vice Chancellor Dr. Bhim Rao Ambedkar University, Agra and Ex-Vice Chancellor, MJP Rohilkhand University, Bareilly covered issues related to 'Why and Wherefore of Teacher Training for Academic Leadership in Higher Education', and 'Governance of Higher Education in India and Interface with Regulatory Bodies'.
