About LEAP

Leadership for Academicians Programm (LEAP) is a three weeks flagship Leadership Development training programme (2 weeks domestic ad one week foreign training for second level academic functionaries in public funded higher education institutions under the Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (PMMNMTT).

Objective

To prepare second tier academic heads who are potentially likely to assume leadership roles in the future.

Purpose

To fulfill a long perceived need of preparing senior faculty, such as Deans, Head of Departments for future governance roles as leaders in academic institutions.

Leadership Development Program

There is a great need to train and develop the individuals presently holding leadership and administrative positions in the higher education sector and also concerted efforts will have to be mounted to prepare large number of people for taking over leadership roles in future at various levels in many different kinds of higher educational institutions.

The specific objectives of the leadership development programmes would be

- To provide visionary leadership and strategic thrust to higher educational institutions leading to academic excellence.
- To lead and enable the academic as well as administrative teams, diverse workforce, through positive work culture and teamwork throughout the institution.
- To facilitate higher education leaders to competently deal with leadership challenges those arise in academic institutions.
- To bring in performance culture and efficiency.

To facilitate innovation and creativity in teaching as well as learning, and overall effectiveness of the institutions. To explore technology for both deeper engagement and wider delivery.

communication skills, understanding and coping with the complexity and challenges of governance in HEIs, financial & general administration.



Aligarh Muslim University

Aligarh Muslim University (AMU) occupies a unique position amongst universities and institutions of higher learning in the country. It was established in 1920, and evolved out of the Mohammedan Anglo-

1877 by the great visionary and social reformer, Sir Syed Ahmad khan. From its very inception, it has kept its door open to the members of all communities and from all corners of the country and the world. The Aligarh Muslim University is the realization of a vision which was broad, far-reaching and realistic.

Spread over 467.6 hectares in the city of Aligarh, Uttar Pradesh, Aligarh Muslim University offers more than 300 courses in the traditional and modern branches of education. It draws students from all states in India and from different countries, especially Africa, West Asia and Southeast Asia. It ranks 8th among the top 20 research universities in India. It has more than 28,000, students, 1,342 teachers and some 5,610 non-teaching staff on its rolls. The university now has 12 faculties comprising 98 teaching departments, 3 academies and 15 centres and institution. A special feature of the university is its residential character with most of the staff and students residing on the campus. There are 19 halls of residence for students with 80 hostels.

What is LEAP:

Leadership for Academicians Programme (LEAP) is a three weeks flagship Leadership Development training programme (02 weeks domestic and one week foreign training) for the second level academic functionaries in the public funded higher education institutions.

Eligibility Criteria:

- ➤ At least 8 years of experience in the grade of Professor.
- ➤ Age below 58 years.
- ➤ At least 30 publications in SCOPUS indexed international journals or UGC approved journals
- ➤ At least 3 years experience in administrative positions
- > Impeccable integrity
- Those who have already attended LEAP Training are **not eligible** to apply again.

Two weeks training will be held at the Aligarh Muslim University, Aligarh tentatively in end December 2019, followed by one week training at Monash University, Melbourne, Australia in February 2020:
